The fruit for this wine was harvested from several vineyard sites in the Wairau and Awatere valleys to create our 'Triple Block' blend. Fruit was picked in outstanding condition, vinified in stainless steel tanks with the focus on producing bright lifted fruit complimented by a light herbal edge.
